

**Business attended to since the February Meeting:**

The March meeting of the Vestry was held via Zoom.

**Call to Order (Hannah Harris): (7:04)**

**Bible Study (Rev. Grey)** – a brief reading from Thessalonians and a short discussion of how to be Christians out in the world.

**Approval of January and February Meeting Minutes**

Sam Wesonga moved to approve the minutes of the January and February meetings and Randy Smith seconded the Motion. There was no discussion and the minutes were approved as written.

**Old Business**

- **IT Policy (Jim Ingram)** – Jim said that he had talked to Alfred about this, but nothing has been set up yet.
  
- **Safe Church Follow-Up (Hannah Harris)** – We are hoping to have Master Deputy Ryne Doxie join us at the April meeting if possible.
  
- **Committee Follow-Up**
  - **Senior Support (Jim Ingram)** – The main idea for senior support was to provide rides to church for older people who need them. Jim thought perhaps this was something the Pastoral Care Committee could or should address, so he brought this up at their March meeting. He said he was not sure of the outcome of the proposition and would check back with Megan Douglas about it.

- o **Bylaws (Hannah Harris)** – Hannah said that she has sent an email to the by-laws team and also to Josh Anderson requesting that he put a notice in Glad Tidings to see if anyone outside of the Vestry might be interested in being on the by-laws team.
- o **Easement** – Scott Beaver, Dave McKinnon and Dee Wallis have agreed to be on the Easement Committee.

### **New Business**

- **Spring Fest (Hannah Harris)** – At this time, no one on the Vestry felt that they could commit to taking charge of the Spring Fest event, so Hannah is going to reach out to David Dykes, who worked on it last year, to see if he would be interested and available to take it on again this year.
- **Calendar Planning (Hannah Harris)** – Hannah raised the idea of an event planning calendar that would include all the events planned for this year that should be on our radar, especially those that might need an event coordinator. The events that came up are:
  - March 28 – Habitat Build Day
  - May 3 – Newcomer’s Brunch at 9:30 (Newcomer’s Committee)
  - May(ish) – Spring Fest
  - Youth Sunday (Jeremy)
  - June – gun violence prevention event
  - Homecoming (Sep last year) (needs a coordinator)
  - Sep 20 – Rise Against Hunger
  - Sep 26 – Fall Workday
  - Fall Newcomer’s Brunch (Newcomer’s Committee)
  - Dec 6 – Day of Giving
- **Pew Refresh (Hannah Harris)** – Hannah noted a need to refresh the newcomer cards and pencils in the pew racks before Holy Week. Emily Jividen volunteered to do this.
- **Glad Tidings Committee + Volunteer Opp Highlight (Hannah Harris)** – At the retreat we discussed highlighting a different committee on a rotating basis each week in Glad Tidings. The purpose of this would be to acquaint church members with the various committees, what they do, and who to contact if they are interested in becoming involved in one of the committees. This task will involve compiling a list of the various committees and their chairs and then having a short write-up sent to Josh for publication. Hannah indicated that she won’t have time to get to this for a while, but it is on her list.
- **Junior Warden (Randy Smith)** – Randy said that his prior time conflict has been resolved and he is now free to take over as Junior Warden.
  - Randy further reported that the Spring Workday on March 14<sup>th</sup> was very successful and he prepared a write up for Glad Tidings and sent it to Josh.

- Randy will need the Junior Warden email, which Hannah will touch base with Alfred about.
  - There was a question raised about building access (keys and door codes). Randy said he will work on a policy and procedures for handling and controlling access.
- **Treasurer / Finance** – Lillis Ward asked how often Bill Sena will be meeting with the Vestry this year and whether or not there was a schedule. He is supposed to meet with us quarterly (perhaps May, Sep, Nov). The finance report is in the Vestry Public folder and Emily Jividen said any specific questions about finances could be addressed to her as liaison to the Finance Committee.
